

Bulletin Board Policy

The lobby of the library contains a bulletin board for display of information by nonprofit organizations for civic, educational, charitable, or cultural activities or events. Community meeting announcements and community cultural events may also be displayed. No commercial or business notices, garage or other sale signs will be posted. In order to avoid the appearance of an endorsement of a candidate for public office, the library will not post posters or other materials that advocate voting for, or support of, particular candidates or parties. However, notices of political events, meetings, or activities may be posted, subject to space limitations. A section shall be available for non-profit and/or public services that are of interest to the general public and provide information about sources of help for the community; such as non-profit referral organizations, educational opportunities, and government assistance notices. Persons wanting a sign posted shall leave it at the Front Desk for the library staff to post. Materials are posted as space permits, no larger than 11"x17". Because of space limitations, the library cannot guarantee that all eligible posters will be displayed. The library shall remove all outdated signs (or after 3 months), any sign found to be posted in violation of the procedure outlined herein, and any sign or poster not in compliance with the above.
