<i>Prunus pumila</i> v. <i>besseyi</i> 'Pawnee Buttes'	dwarf sand cherry	low spreading shrub native western IA
<i>Rosa arkansana</i>	prairie rose	accent shrub, protect from deer
<i>Rosa carolina</i>	pasture roes	accent shrub, protect from deer
<i>Rhus aromatica</i> v. <i>arenaria</i> 'Gro-Low'	dwarf fragrant sumac	low spreading native shrub
<i>Salix humilis</i>	prairie willow	low native shrub
<b>Grasses For Sunny Sites</b>		
<i>Schizachyrium scoparium</i>	little bluestem	accent native grass, 30" tall
<i>Carex brevior</i>	plains oval sedge	accent plant
<i>Sporobolus heterolepis</i>	prairie dropseed	accent grass, blooms smell like popcorn
<b>Sun Perennial Ground Covers, Accents</b>		
<i>Asclepias tuberosa</i>	butterflyweed	native, accent plant
<i>Asclepias verticillata</i>	whorled milkweed	native, accent plant, can spread
<i>Coreopsis lanceolata</i>	lanceleaf tickseed	native to Missouri, Illinois, accent plant
<i>Coreopsis palmata</i>	prairie tickseed	native, accent plant
<i>Heliopsis helianthoides</i> 'Tuscan Sun'	dwarf false sunflower	native cultivar, dwarf form, accent plant
<i>Rudbeckia fulgida</i>	orange cone flower	native to Illinois, accent plant
<i>Rudbeckia missouriensis</i>	Missouri black-eyed Susan	accent plant
<i>Solidago missouriensis</i>	Missouri goldenrod	native, not as tall
<i>Solidago nemoralis</i>	gray goldenrod	native, accent plant, can spread
<i>Symphyotricum oblongifolium</i> 'October Skies'	aromatic aster	native, accent plant
<i>Symphyotricum ericoides prostratum</i>	creeping heath aster	native, low growing form
<i>Viola pedatifida</i>	prairie violet	native violet, accent plant
<i>Viola sororia</i>	common violet	native violet,
