<i>Fragaria virginiana</i>	wild strawberry	native, spreading ground cover
<i>Geranium maculatum</i>	wild geranium	native, spreading ground cover
<i>Helianthus strumosus</i>	woodland sunflower	native, spreading ground cover 3 ft. tall
<i>Parthenocissus quinquefolia</i>	Virginia creeper	native vine or ground cover
<i>Phlox divaricata</i>	woodland phlox	native, accent plant, protect from rabbits
<i>Podophyllum peltatum</i>	mayapple	native ephemeral ground cover
<i>Polemonium reptans</i>	Jacob's ladder	native, accent plant
<i>Solidago flexicaulis</i>	zig zag goldenrod	native, accent plant
<i>Solidago ulmifolia</i>	elm-leaf goldenrod	native, accent plant
<i>Symphyotricum cordifolium</i>	woodland aster	native, spreads by seed
<i>Viola sororia</i>	common violet	native accent or ground cover, flws spring
